REPORTS

Paramount Cinema

B. Barnsley reported on the following:

Two new relief attendants had been employed on a three month trial.
Very few dates were remaining for live events which are selling well.
For the benefit of the new members Mr. Barnsley explained all the staff duties.
Films for the summer were being sorted.
A new coffee machine had been ordered.

Paramount Budget Report:

Amanda Hart the Finance Officer presented members with a documented account of the Paramount’s financial affairs. Members present appeared satisfied with the information given.

Resource Centre:

The Town clerk explained to the new members about the long term lease of the building to Sure Start and the exterior condition of the building.

Quotes had been received to clad the building with upvc instead of re - staining. The quote was in the region of £8,000.00. Therefore it was recommended that a rolling programme to carry out this work in sections subject to ratification by full council would be carried out.

Community Centre:

The Town Clerk also stated that new fire doors had been installed from the kitchen in to the yard in the top hall and new doors to the I.T. and Bar Rooms.

Decorating following the damp proofing of the seminar room was to be carried out in the very near future.

It was also recommended that the doors to the lower hall and kitchen were to be refurbished
