**Minutes of the Development and Regeneration Committee meeting held on
January 11th 2016 in the I.T. Room St. Johns Community Centre Penistone at 7.0 pm**

1. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

Apologies for absence were accepted from Cllrs. Hand – Davis, Denton, Hinchliff and Mrs. Hinchliff

2. DECLARATIONS OF PERSONAL OR PREJUDICIAL INTEREST

The **Chair** invited personal or prejudicial interests from members to which there were **NONE**

3. PROGRESSION OF THE PENISTONE NEIGHBOURHOOD DEVELOPMENT PLAN

Prior to the meeting proper Cllr. Unsworth asked for differentiation purposes could the group be named Penistone Neighbourhood Development Plan Steering Group as opposed to the Development and Regeneration Committee, following a brief discussion, for future reference it was agreed this course of action.

- a) Grant Status: Cllr. Webber confirmed that £7,030.00 had so far been applied for and accepted however not yet received this would need to be spent before the end of March. Expenditure to date had been from the £5,000.00 Town Council grant.
- b) Website & Social Media Status: Stuart Gibbons reported that a separate website was being built and this will go “live” when the full content is received and this could be within two days upon receipt. Cllr. Webber agreed to send the Parish Boundary map and details of what a Neighbourhood Plan entails for inclusion and Penistone F.M. has agreed to put a link to the website.
1,000 flyers were distributed at the Christmas Light switch on to residents and businesses Cllr. Ogle was thanked for his involvement.
- c) Project Logo: The preferred logo was accepted unanimously by the Committee with Cllr. Webber confirming he had arranged a site meeting with a planning officer from Barnsley MBC on the siting of the advertising banners.
- d) Next Steps: David Gluck circulated the latest draft plan and would review the evidence of the previous Community Led Plan and its content. This would then need to be dismantled and new surveys would need to be carried out by other consultants. and priorities reassembled as the main core of the N.D.P. He highlighted six themes as these priorities:
Housing, Economy, Built Environment, Countryside and Green Space,
Community Facilities and Low Carbon.
