Beever,** it was agreed to increase the budget by 1.5% and set the precept for 2015/16 from the existing £162,063.00 (£151, 582.00 precept and £10, 481.00 council tax support grant) to £163,710.00 (£153,850.00 precept and £9,860.00 council tax support grant) and that the expenditure for the financial year 2015/16 is monitored stringently.
