Penistone Area Team

The Area Team works across the whole of the Penistone Area (East and West Electoral Wards) on behalf of Barnsley Council. Our role is to support residents, community groups and Councillors to work together to improve our communities and the quality of life for the people who live and work here.

We work in partnership with others to help ensure that Penistone receives the support it needs in order to help address local needs.

We support local groups and voluntary organisations by offering guidance and information, signposting, identify training and funding opportunities, the recruitment of volunteers, publicity and development of projects.



Penistone East, Penistone West

Working as part of Barnsley Council's Area Arrangements, the Penistone Area Council is made up of locally elected Councillors. They use local information from residents to set the area priorities. They also take into account national sources such as the census.





Penistone Ward Alliance is a group of community representatives who have put themselves forward to work with the councillors to look at addressing local priorities. On behalf of Barnsley Council, the Ward Alliance works in partnership with others for the benefit of the ward and supports the community to build upon its strength, skills and resilience.

They hold a small budget called the Penistone Ward Alliance Fund which groups can apply to for funding to help deliver projects which contribute towards addressing the ward priorities. The funding can support and develop both existing and new groups. There is also an additional funding pot available called the Schools Out Fund. This is available for groups who are looking to deliver free family activities during school holidays.
