		<p>further update since. Nothing changed, still parking on pavement on corner. Regularly patrolled by officers, but to take any action, need to prove which car parked first causing the blockage. Bus service threatened to be cut due to issues. Jill will get in touch with Parking Services again.</p> <p>16.01.2024 – Jill emailed Parking Operations requesting more patrols. SYP will also conduct more patrols</p> <p>06.03.2024 – Following this meeting, Jill emailed Alan Turner (Parking Operations) and Damon Brown (Highways Technical). More patrols were requested from Parking with a view to issuing FPNs where appropriate and Damon was asked for a site visit. Jill advised attendees she would draft a joint partnership letter that would be hand delivered by PCSOs. Jill also asked for residents to submit complaints online directly to the above mentioned Services, with photos where possible, as this may add extra 'teeth' to the complaint</p>

Margaret Cotterill	<p>Raised the issue of no street lights lit on Park Avenue for a number of weeks, and residents are concerned about the lack of security associated with it. This occurred at a similar time last year. Nigel followed it up last year and was told it was the responsibility of the National Grid, not BMBC.</p>	<p>10.01.2024 – Back on before Christmas, were off for 50 days. Been told is to do with cabling, seems to occur when there is a bad storm.</p> <p>Jill contacted Northern Powergrid again on 16.01.2024. They have advised a ref number from BMBC Streetlighting is required from when they reported the issue (wasn't made aware of this previously) and then they can look into it further.</p> <p>Once given reference ref number, Jill contacted NPG</p>	

		<p>18.01.2024 and was told there was a “multiple fuse replacement required” and it was an “intermittent fault”. Because it is intermittent, they are trying to find the location of the fault otherwise they would have to dig up the full length of the street (very disruptive and costly). Jill asked for a time limit when works may be completed and was told it was down to capacity and resources. Also told the time of year it happens, the last two years in a row, was purely coincidental Mrs Cotterill updated</p> <p>06.03.2024 – Lights back on. Should the issue arise again for the third year in a row residents advised it is the responsibility of Northern Power Grid. Discharged</p>
